

For ease of reference, and clarity, where aspects of Kickapoo Dwelling are unusual, certain phrases used on this site for areas of the Dwelling are defined or described as follows:

Deck Gazebo - That portion of the outside deck (and continuing to the east as the Covered Back Deck and the South as the Living Room Deck) at the northwest corner of the residence roofed over with a roof fully tied into the house roof, not enclosed, with a wood fire place back to back with the gas fireplace inside the residence.

Solar Trombe Wall - The 175 square foot interior stonewall facing the tall south window wall and separated from it by the Solar Corridor.

Solar Corridor - The tiled internal walkway, between the Solar Trombe Wall and the south window wall, allowing access to the two bedrooms and the guest bath as well as from and to the living, dining, kitchen and loft areas of the residence and the utility room and garage.

Solar Trellis & Deck - The external walk way to the south of the south window wall between the drive way / garage and the front door, the trellis portion of which is an integral part of the passive solar system, in that the 22 degree slant of the horizontal portion allows the low winter sun access to the Solar Trombe Wall, while shading that Wall from the high summer sun.

Covered Back Deck - The deck on the north outside of the residence connecting the garage (and the bedrooms) to the Deck Gazebo, covered by the main roof of the residence.

Living Room Deck - The uncovered deck on the west outside of the residence.

Loft Office Library - The loft area, above the kitchen and dinning area, housing a double cockpit work area, a conference table and library book shelves.

Wind / Solar Energy Generators - The 120 foot wind turbine tower and photovoltaic array, and associated equipment, located up hill to the south of the residence
