

## **Relationship Understanding**

### **Between Kickapoo and Its Partners**

Kickapoo Mud Creek Nature Conservancy has the following understanding with all of its Partners in the use of Kickapoo Center and the Kickapoo web site:

- ◆ Only non-governmental not for profit organizations may be Partners of Kickapoo
- ◆ A Partner should, preferably, have at least one major focus of its activities physically in, or nearby, Ogle County, Illinois
- ◆ A Partner should encourage cooperation and partnering with like minded local organizations and governmental agencies (such as park districts)
- ◆ A Partner should have one or more of the following areas of interest of Kickapoo:
  - Prairies, renaturalization, and maintenance of degraded land
  - Alternative energy generation (solar, wind, etc.)
  - Energy conservation (insulation, LED lights, etc.)
  - Green construction & maintenance
  - Searching for compatibility of agricultural and natural land use
  - Highlighting local history of the land and its people
- ◆ A Partner may use the facilities of Kickapoo Center
- ◆ A Partner is given direct access to the Calendar portion of this web site to schedule and post its meetings, events, and presentations and directly reserve access to, and use of, the facilities of the Center for holding them
- ◆ A Partner may permanently leave materials at the Center for distribution to other users of the center and their members and audiences
- ◆ Within limits of space availability, a Partner may store equipment and materials for its use at the Center
- ◆ A Partner is expected to see to, immediately following use of the Center, returning the Center to the condition it was in prior to use
- ◆ Donations from a Partner in support of the maintenance of the Center is welcomed, but not required
